Cataloger Hierarchy

Level II and III catalogers

Level II and III catalogers are limited to specific records for editing.

For example, no authority records can be created or edited (LC or VIAF).

For Manuscript Objects, the following fields are not editable by level II or III catalogers

- Subject
- Genre/Form and associated URI field
- Uniform Title plus LC and VIAF fields
- Author Display

Tip: To edit a record, first search and retrieve it using the search panel on the left of the cataloging page.

Level I catalogers

- Catalogers with level I privileges are able to edit and delete any record.
- Can assign records to level II and level III catalogers by entering a user's email address in the Record Creator field.
- Can add and edit Authority Lists.

Remember: once a display name has been entered for someone (e.g. author) in a record, it can be changed but it can't be removed/erased.

Reading Room is a comprehensive library of manuscripts, films and more. Reading Room does not include HMML's collections. You can view a [list of collections](#) already in Reading Room. For other collections, you can consult the [Legacy Catalog](#) or see a [list of uncataloged collections](#).

How to Use Search


Date range / undated manuscripts: Once you activate the Date Range slider, manuscripts with no date, or no cataloger-supplied data, will be excluded from the results. For undated manuscripts a cataloger often suggests an approximate century, but some records have no date whatsoever. If you use the Date Range slider, set it with generous room on either side of your target date.

Native script: You can use Unicode characters for native script when searching Names and Titles, or for Keyword or Incipit searches. Note that native script appears only when useful for describing the manuscript, such as in notes, provenance, or other fields where transliteration cannot be used.
