

Basic preservation works: inventory lists (basic cataloguing), boxes (conservation), reconstructed libraries (as of May 2020)

Total to be done since 2013: 377,491 manuscripts in 35 libraries to be inventoried and boxed (43,317 boxes needed); 45 libraries to be reconstructed/rehabilitated.
